- For full-time postgraduate students wishing to apply for a Student Visa, if you are 25 years and above, then your last qualification certificate/degree and transcripts should be attested from the following government agencies in your home country:
 - Ministry of Higher Education
 - Ministry of Foreign affairs
 - UAE Consulate*

*NOTE: Nigerian Nationals/Residents - As there is no UAE Consulate Office in Nigeria, we can process the UAE Consulate attestations on behalf of Nigerian nationals/residents wishing to apply for our student visa.



GUIDANCE NOTES

Documents to be attached with application form

Before submitting this application form, please ensure that all sections of the form have been completed and where appropriate the following items have been attached. Failure to include these items may slow the processing of your application. Do not send original documentation at this stage. The University will not normally return documentation submitted and will not be held liable for original documentation which is lost or damaged in any manner. Please be prepared to present original copies of all documentation to the university at enrolment for verification.

- Copies of all High School certificates, transcripts and other academic documentation.
- Personal Statement (a minimum of 200 words)
- 2 references (Academic or Employment references on official letterhead of Referee)
- Photocopy of passport (including photograph and personal details page)
- Copy of valid UAE Residency Visa (if you do not wish to apply for a student visa through Middlesex University Dubai)
- Detailed and updated Resume/Curriculum Vitae (required for mature applicants over the age of 21, and postgraduate programme applicants)
- Photocopies of IELTS/TOEFL or other approved English qualification if applicable
- 2 Passport size photos
- For advanced entry applicants requesting credit transfer/top-up - Submit transcripts AND syllabus of Higher Education level programme**

How to write a 'Personal Statement'

A personal statement is your chance to tell the university why you are applying for this programme, and why they should want you as a student. The admissions officer will want to know why you are interested in the programme you have applied for and what you hope to do after your studies. A good personal statement is important and should help to persuade an admissions officer to offer a place. In many cases, applicants are not interviewed, so this may be your only chance to make a case for your admission.

There is no set format for a personal statement. Consider carefully the information you give to support your application and the best way to present it effectively. Remember, you must be truthful and accurate in what you write. It is up to you how you write your statement but we suggest you include some or all of the following points:

- Why you have chosen the programme(s) you have listed?
- What interests you about your chosen subject? Include details of what you have read about the subject.
- Why do you want the British learning experience and British qualification?
- Why do you want to study in Dubai?
- What career plans do you have for when you complete your course?
- Any job, work experience, placement or voluntary work you have done or applied for particularly if it is relevant to your subject. You may want to describe the skills and experience you have gained from these activities.
- Any subject studied for which you do not have formal assessment.
- Your social, sports or leisure interests.

If the space provided is insufficient, you can attach extra pages. Just ensure your statement is precise and clear. If you wish to send more information, a CV is a good way to submit this. Please attach your CV to the application form if you feel it is appropriate.

How to write a 'Reference'

You should write the reference? The person who writes a reference for you should know you well enough to write about you and to judge if you are suitable for higher education. We will not accept references from family, other relatives or friends. You must have a full written reference: the name and address of the referee are not enough. If you are at school or college, or you have only left recently, you should ask your Head Teacher, Principal or an appropriate teacher or tutor to write your reference. This must be on an official school letterhead.

If you are a mature student, you should ask a responsible person who knows you. This could be an employer, training officer, career officer, a teacher on a recent relevant further education course, or a senior colleague in employment or in voluntary work.

Guidance for referees: We would appreciate if you could use your letterhead paper. Please give an assessment of the suitability of the applicant for the higher education programme(s) they have applied for, and where possible, include the following points:

- Existing achievement, with particular reference to subject relating to the programme(s) for which they have applied.
- Potential, including predicted results or performance.
- Motivation and commitment towards the chosen course(s).
- Any relevant skills and/or achievement, whether certified or not.
- Powers of analysis and independent thought.
- Any factors which may have affected, or will affect in the future, their performance, for example personal circumstances, performance under pressure, etc...
- Information about any special needs and other requirements.

Documents required for application for student visa (*to be submitted to the Dubai authorities by Middlesex University Dubai on behalf of students who need a student visa after admission has been confirmed*):

1. Student enrolment contract copy (Provided by Middlesex University Dubai).
2. Proof of funds: An original copy of bank statement not older than ten (10) days, officially stamped by the bank, showing a minimum balance of AED30,000 is required.
3. Visa fee of AED 1,000 for a visa which is valid for one year (The fee for extension of student visa is AED 700 for every additional year).
4. Approval from Knowledge Village office (Provided by Middlesex University Dubai).
5. Three passport copies including the personal details page (passport must be valid for at least 6 months).
6. Eight passport size photographs.
7. Copy of offer/acceptance letter from Middlesex University Dubai.
8. Copy of receipts showing payment for tuition and visa fees.

Predecessors to Middlesex University – a proud heritage

Middlesex Polytechnic was formed in 1973 and brought together:

- Enfield College of Technology (founded as Ponders End Technical Institute in 1901)
- Hendon College of Technology (founded as Hendon Technical Institute in 1938)
- Hornsey College of Art (founded as Hornsey School of Arts and Crafts in 1882)

Later, the following institutions joined the Polytechnic:

- Trent Park College of Education (founded 1947) became part of the Polytechnic in 1974
- New College of Speech and Drama (founded 1962) joined Middlesex in 1974
- St Katharine's College (1878-1964) and Berridge House, Hampstead (1893-1964) formed The College of All Saints (1964) which joined Middlesex in 1978.

Following the establishment of Middlesex University in 1992:

- The London College of Dance in Bedford joined in 1994
- North London College of Health joined as the Faculty of Health Studies in 1995.

Middlesex – an English County

Middlesex was one of the 29 historic counties of England. It no longer exists as a county, but it is still recognised as a postal address in Greater London.



Middlesex became a shire in the 10th Century and later became one of the 39 historic counties of England. Middlesex ceased to exist as a separate county on 31 March 1965 when, together with parts of Essex, Hertfordshire, Kent and Surrey, it became part of the administrative area known as Greater London.

The Middlesex county shield includes seaxes – Anglo-Saxon or Viking daggers – and a Saxon crown.

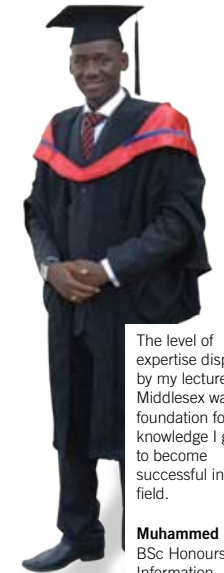
